How to Make it Happen?

Creating Unity + Clarity

Preparation is important

- Communicate to your team on time.

time, place, when, how long

Prepare ahead of time

check ^{self} → Give grace + get grace

You have to have a rehearsal

Practice the presence of God

Give complete setlist

Dates for Songs

Have a target = Map out the Practice = Bathroom Break

Start with something you know

Pay attention to the fatigue.

Don't give them any excuses

Have backup Plans (Plan B)

Provide recordings of the songs

Keep it fun + Encouraging

Keep Practice Spiritual

You have responsibility | → Practice at home

Come Prepared | → Rehearse at Rehearsal

Equipment → come early, does it work? Beat Practice

Never ever have a favorite

Don't Play through a whole song if you don't have to

Work on your transitions
